



Quail Valley Proud 2020 Scholarship Application

Quail Valley Proud (QVP) Scholarships are awarded to graduating senior high school students who have lived in Quail Valley for a minimum of the last four (4) years. Applications are to be postmarked no later than May 18th of the year prior to the academic year for which they are requesting support. All information submitted will be held in confidence and used solely for the purpose of scholarship administration.

Instructions:

1. Please fill the application out by hand or by using a PDF writer. Make sure your handwriting is legible if you elect to write by hand.
2. Print or type your name on each page.
3. Print or type information on all required pages. Do not substitute forms. Minimal additional supplemental information may be accepted.
4. Print or type an essay and include it with your application as directed on page 5. The essay must be the original thoughts of the applicant, in the applicant's own words, written by the applicant.
5. Provide the recommendation instructions to your Sponsor (ie: High School or Community Representatives) as described on page 6. Recommendations must be printed or typed and included with submission of the full application or emailed to events@quailvalleyproud.com.
6. DO NOT attach a copy of your high school transcript. We do not need them.
7. Complete all information. Failure to do so may result in elimination.
8. Successful applicants will be required to allow Quail Valley Proud to take a photograph of themselves that may be used to promote the Quail Valley Proud Scholarship program.
9. It is suggested that you have your application reviewed by the individual writing your recommendation, parent or someone else to insure completeness and accuracy.
10. Completed applications and recommendations can be submitted electronically to events@quailvalleyproud.com, and must be received by May 18, 2020. Applications can also be submitted to the address below. Applications postmarked before May 18th will be accepted. Please do not staple or bind your application documents.
